SVHC: Substances of Very High Concern

The REACH legislation (Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006) entered into force on June 1st, 2007 to streamline and improve the former legislative framework on chemicals of the European Union (EU). Substances in volumes over one metric ton per year either manufactured in or imported into the EU must be registered under REACH.

We can confirm that none of our products sold to you contain any substance of very high concern (SVHC) as proposed by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) according to the definition in Article 57 of Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 ("The REACH regulation") at concentrations levels $> 0.1\%$ as stated in Article 56 of the previously mentioned Regulation. This list was published in October 28th 2008 and updated the 5th of November 2025.

Nevertheless, we cannot exclude the presence of traces of all these substances, in the amount of ppm, deriving from raw material impurities or coming from manufacturing equipment or processes or as omnipresent contaminants.
