To Whom It May Concern,

This Directive took effect from 22nd July 2019 and is aimed at eradicating certain hazardous substances from new electrical and electronic equipment. Brett Martin fully endorses the guiding principles of the legislation and is committed to ensuring that our products are compliant with the regulations where appropriate.

All rigid PVC (flat sheet, corrugated sheet, pipes, profiles and foam sheet), PMMA, PC (flat, hard-coat, corrugated and multi-wall), aPET, PETg and PS products and their associated packaging are compliant with this legislation, containing none of the materials described in the legislation.

The restricted substances are outlined below:

Cadmium (Cd): < (0.01%)
Lead (Pb): < (0.1%)
Mercury (Hg): < (0.1%)
Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI): < (0.1%)
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB): < (0.1%)
Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): < (0.1%)
Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) Phthalate (DEHP): < (0.1%)
Benzyl Butyl Phthalate (BBP): < (0.1%)
Dibutyl Phthalate (DBP): < (0.1%)
Diisobutyl Phthalate (DIBP): < (0.1%)
